Community

Creating community-based health and social care services.

We want to improve the accessibility of community-based health and social care services by improving access to specialist services close to home. We will also work towards developing inclusive communities, providing more opportunities for people with a learning disability to safely participate in activities.



WHAT IS IMPORTANT TO PEOPLE WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES?

People with learning disabilities would like to feel like they belong, are connected with others, and can contribute to communities through volunteering and activities.

They would like to feel protected in their communities, as they can sometimes experience discrimination and name-calling, which makes them feel like a target.

They would like communities to feel inclusive, and for activities to accommodate a range of complex needs so they can participate in community life.

WHAT WE WILL DO TOGETHER:

- Ensure everyone has adequate opportunity to access them without the barriers of complications.
- Review community-based daytime opportunities.
- Make sure community hubs are accessible and relevant to people with learning disability.

WHAT DIFFERENCE WILL THIS MAKE?

- More inclusive communities, providing more opportunities for people with a learning disability to safely participate in activities.
- People with a learning disability feel part of their communities.
- Reduced stigma and discrimination.
